Billi Billi Shiraz is sourced from a selection of premium cool climate vineyards throughout Victoria; predominantly the Grampians including a portion from the Mount Langi Ghiran vineyards, home of the iconic Langi Shiraz.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Dense, deep garnet.

Nose: Spiced aromatics, intense black fruits.

Palate: Bright black berry fruits form the core, laced with spices of clove, liquorice and florals. Finely structured tannins frame this medium bodied, generous wine, finishing with good balance and length.

Cellar: Drink now until 2022.

Region: Victoria

Vineyard(s): Grampians, Swan Hill, Beechworth

Vine age: Various. Average 27 years.

Harvest date: March/May 2016

Harvest Method: 95% Machine + 5% Hand

WINEMAKING

Fermentation method: Various sized open fermenters which are plunged and pumped over daily.

Barrel origin: 100% French oak

Barrel age: Various. Small portion of new oak.
