

# 2017 Versions South Australia Shiraz

The Original Travel Story:

**They say it's about the journey not the destination so he closed his eyes and threw a dart at the map**

*A strong yet approachable wine with hidden depths and an appealing soft side. This version can handle rich food yet is relaxed enough for a friendly barbecue.*

**Vintage: 2017**

Good rains during winter and spring were welcome, especially after the hot and dry 2016 season. A relatively mild season brought harvest back to within average timing and fruit quality was generally high.

**Winemaking:**

The fruit was picked at full ripeness to provide vibrant fruit flavours. This wine is made to drink now and has had light oak treatment to promote soft and rounded tannins.

**Tasting Note:**

A serious yet approachable wine with a deep bright crimson colour. From warm vineyards in South Australia, the fruit was picked at optimum ripeness to give a rich and generous wine with intense fruit flavours and soft, rounded tannin. Light oak treatment adds depth, flavour and texture but does not overshadow the juicy fruit of a standout vintage.
