Notes from Harvest:

The year began with abundant rainfall, followed by a mild Spring resulting in extended flowering with little shatter. Most of the growing season provided consistently average temperatures before a Labor Day weekend heatwave kicked harvest into high gear. Then, optimal climate conditions followed through the first week of October and promoted even ripening until the fruit was ready to be harvested.

Tasting Notes:

Our 2017 Napa Jazz shows ripe berry aromas of blueberry, raspberry, and pomegranate with undercurrents of black pepper and dark chocolate. It's well-structured on the palate with firm tannins, inviting acidity, and a pleasant lingering finish.
