

2014 Spenker Estate Zinfandel

Lodi soft tannins and oak vanillin give This Zinfandel a pleasing texture. The wine is fruit forward, and there is a sense of cinnamon spice in the mouth. Black cherry and blackberry with transient black pepper flavors make it capable of standing alone or enhancing an evening meal.

Grapes harvested September 3 & 6, 2014. Aged in a combination of French and American barrels for 14 months. Bottled in December, 2015. 399 cases produced.
